## Single Stream Recycling

No sorting on your end makes recycling quick and easy! Recyclables should be empty and rinsed clean of food residue. Lids and caps may be loosely replaced on their containers. Please do not tie newspaper, magazines or cardboard with twine.

Plastic bags and Styrofoam are trash and cannot be recycled!
