CONTAINERS & PAPER

Recyclables should be empty and rinsed clean of food residue.

Lids and caps may be loosely replaced on their containers.

Please do not tie newspaper, magazines or cardboard with twine.

Plastic bags and Styrofoam are trash; please do not put in regular recycling!

Food Scraps

Let's Scrap Food Waste!

- Less regular trash
- Preserves resources
- Required by state law
- Gets turned into BrattleGrow compost, enriching soils

Drop off the collected food scraps in the dumpster at the facility.

Household Trash

Readsboro requires an access sticker, \$25 at Town Office or Transfer Station.

Trash: \$2 for up to 32-gal bag.

\$20 per cubic yard for furniture/construction debris



Readsboro's comprehensive Transfer Station also takes these items:

scrap metal; appliances; batteries; electronics; fluorescent bulbs; tires; used motor oil; leaf & yard waste
