## ACCESS PERMITS (windshield stickers)

Valid for a year, July 1<sup>st</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year. No prorated permits will be sold. The next year's permits go on sale May 1<sup>st</sup> each year.

- Annual Permit** .....\$50
- Single Day Pass** (for one business day) .....\$15

## SERVICES with an ACCESS PERMIT



### Household Trash

- 33-gallon bag or smaller..... \$4 per bag
- Contractor bag .....\$8 per bag
- 32-gallon barrel.....\$12 ea.
- All other trash .....\$20 for up to 200 lb.
- Over 200 lb. (by weight on the scale).....\$190 per ton

### Construction Debris

- Minimum disposal fee.....\$20 for up to 200 lb.
- Over 200 lb. (by weight on the scale) ..... \$190 per ton

### Household Items

- Vacuum .....\$4
- Gas Grill .....\$5
- Mattress/Box Spring (Twin/Full/Futon) ...\$12.50 ea.
- Mattress/Box Spring (Queen/King).....\$20 ea.
- Chair/Recliner/Loveseat.....\$15
- Sofa.....\$20
- Sleeper Sofa .....\$25
- Sectional .....\$40

### Tires

- Bicycle .....\$3
- Passenger vehicle (includes motorcycles, pickups).....\$4
- Passenger vehicle on the rim .....\$7
- Truck/Tractor/Loader or Bulk Loads ..(call for pricing)

### Recycling

Paper and Bottles & Cans, see back page

### Leaves & Grass Clippings

No brush, logs or branches  
(More than 5 bags of grass clippings subject to fees)

### Motor Oil

Used motor oil; cannot have any gasoline, water, dirt. or antifreeze (IS CHARGE FOR ANY 5 GALLON BUCKET)

## NO ACCESS PERMIT required



**House Paint** Oil, Stains, Latex, Polyurethane..... Free  
(10-gallon limit per day, no spray paint or thinner)

### Electronics

- Computers, TVs, Printers, Peripherals ..... Free
- Businesses >10 employees bringing 7+ units are subject to fees
- Other electronics.....\$5 ea.
- e.g. DVD, game console, cable box, stereo (\$20 for large items)

### Batteries

- Primary (regular AA, AAA, C, D, button) ..... Free
- Rechargeable (Lithium, NiCad)..... Free
- Small Lead-Acid (lawnmower, motorcycle) ..... \$3
- Large Lead-Acid (Car/Truck/Marine) ..... \$5

### Fluorescent Lightbulbs

- CFLs (spiral lightbulbs) ..... Free
- Straight Tubes up to 10 units ..... Free
- Straight Tubes more than 10 units..... \$0.20/ft
- Ballasts (PCB/non-PCB) .....\$6/\$3

**Clothing, Shoes, Sheets, Accessories** ..... Free

**Books** (Roundabout Books)..... Free  
Hardcover, paperbacks, cookbooks

**Scrap Metal** (by the load, sm/med/lg)..... \$5/\$10/\$20

**Appliances** (Please remove doors from refrigerators & freezers)  
With Freon (A/C, dehumidifiers, freezers, fridges) ..... \$15  
Without Freon (microwaves, dishwashers, etc.) ..... \$10  
Commercial Equipment..... \$30

### Propane and other Tanks

- Camp Tank (1 lb.)..... \$1.50
- Grill Tank (20 lb.) ..... \$10
- Insulation Tank (spray foam)..... \$25
- Fire Extinguisher..... \$5

**Brush/Logs/Stumps/Grass** ... \$10 min, or \$100 per ton  
(by weight on the scale)

Office paper  
Junk mail  
Newspaper

Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs, & lids

Metal cans  
Foil: clean & balled up

**CARDBOARD BIN**

Shipping boxes, Cereal boxes, Egg cartons, Tissue boxes, Roll cores from paper towels

**GLASS BIN**

Only glass bottles and jars.  
No lids, No other glass

**5¢ BINS**

Only bottles and cans with VT 5¢ deposit

**NO!** Please keep out of all recycle bins:

No Plastic Bags      No Styrofoam      No Plant Pots or Flats
