ACCESS PERMITS (windshield stickers)

Valid for a year, July 1st through June 30th of each year. No prorated permits will be sold. The next year's permits go on sale May 1st each year.

Minimum disposal fee	\$20 for up to 200 lb.

Used motor oil; cannot have any gasoline, water, dirt. or antifreeze (\$5 CHARGE FOR ANY 5 GALLON BUCKET)
