## Dual Stream Recycling

### CONTAINERS & PAPER

Recyclables should be empty and rinsed clean of food residue. Lids and caps may be loosely replaced on their containers.

Please do not tie newspaper, magazines or cardboard with twine.

**Plastic bags and Styrofoam are trash; please do not put in regular recycling!**



**Bottles & Cans  
Plastic #1-7  
Aluminum**



**NO Plastic Bags, NO Styrofoam**



**Paper**

Please flatten cardboard



**NO waxed paper**

e.g. juice cartons,  
ice cream cartons
