ACCESS PERMITS (windshield stickers)

Valid for a year, July 1st through June 30th of each year.
The next year's permits go on sale May 1st each year.

Annual Permit	\$60
½ year permit (Available after Jan. 1).....	\$35
Single-Day Pass	\$15

SERVICES with an ACCESS PERMIT

Household Trash

33-gallon bag or smaller.....	\$5 per bag
Contractor bag	\$10 per bag
32-gallon barrel	\$15 ea.
All other trash.....	\$30 for up to 275 lbs.
Over 275 lbs. (by weight on the scale)	\$215 per ton

Construction Debris

Minimum disposal fee.....	\$30 for up to 275 lbs.
Over 275 lbs. (by weight on the scale).....	\$215 per ton

Household Items

Vacuum	\$5
Gas Grill	\$5
Mattress/Box Spring (All sizes).....	\$25 ea.
Chair/Recliner/Loveseat.....	\$15
Sofa, and/or sectional	\$25
Sleeper Sofa.....	\$30

Tires

Passenger vehicle (includes motorcycles, pickups).....	\$5

Alkaline (regular AA, AAA, C, D, button)	Free
Rechargeable (Lithium, NiCad).....	Free
Small Lead-Acid (lawnmower, motorcycle)	\$4
Large Lead-Acid (Car/Truck/Marine)	\$6

Fluorescent Lightbulbs

CFLs (spiral lightbulbs)	Free
Straight Tubes up to 10 units	Free
Straight Tubes more than 10 units.....	\$0.25/ft
Ballasts (PCB/non-PCB)	\$6/\$3

Appliances

With Freon (A/C, dehumidifiers, freezers, fridges)	\$25

Propane and other Tanks

Camp Tank (1 lb.).....	\$2.50
Grill Tank (20 lb.)	\$10
Insulation Tank (spray foam).....	\$25
Fire Extinguisher.....	\$5

Brush/Logs/Stumps/Grass ... \$10 min, or \$100 per ton
(by weight on the scale)

Oil filters (small/large).....\$.50/\$1.00 ea.

MOTOR OIL IS ONLY COLLECTED ON TUESDAYS (10/1/24)

Motor oil (clean oil).....\$1.00 per gallon
can be used or unused but must be clean- no
contaminants as we burn this in our waste oil furnace.

Motor oil (dirty oil).....\$10.00 per gallon

This must be disposed of as Hazardous Waste, and
only collected on Tuesdays @ HHW Depot (May-Oct),
or at the scale.

Office paper
Junk mail
Newspaper

Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs, & lids

Metal cans
Foil: clean & balled up

CARDBOARD BIN

Shipping boxes, Cereal boxes, Egg cartons,
Tissue boxes, Roll cores from paper towels

GLASS BIN

Only glass bottles and jars.
No lids, No other glass

5¢ BINS

Only bottles and cans with VT 5¢ deposit

NO! Please keep out of all recycle bins:

No Plastic Bags No Styrofoam No Plant Pots or Flats
